Procedures to Remove Academic Registration Hold College of Agriculture

An Academic Registration Hold was placed on your record because of your academic performance during your last semester. In order for you to drop/add classes, you must have the Academic Registration Hold cleared. To remove the Academic Registration Hold, use the following steps to have the delinquency removed:

- You must schedule an appointment with your academic advisor to discuss what led to your low academic performance and what plans you have for improvement. If you have already pre-enrolled, you should discuss changes that may be needed in your schedule for the next semester.
- Complete the *Petition for Removal of Academic Registration Hold* and email the form to your academic advisor.
- Your advisor must sign the petition.
- Email your completed Petition for Removal of Academic Registration Hold to the Ag Student Records Office at agrecords@ksu.edu. A signature from the Academic Programs Office will be obtained at that time and the Academic Registration Hold will be removed.
- Once the hold is released, you can proceed with the dropping/adding of your classes.
- If you previously attended K-State and are returning after a semester or more off, you
 must also submit a *Readmission Application* to the University and have the *Academic Registration Hold* removed prior to enrollment. Applications for readmission are
